About Course

Question-01 What is the type of Programme Offered?

Answer: It is a Certificate Course/Value-Added Course.

Question-02 What is the title of the Course?

Answer: Certificate Course/Value Added Course on Insolvency & Bankruptcy Code (IBC).

Question-03 Who is offering this Course?

Answer: Certificate Course/Value-Added Course on Insolvency & Bankruptcy Code (IBC) is offered by Centre for Lex Tax & IBC (hereinafter wards CLTIBC) Maharashtra National Law University Mumbai (hereinafter wards MNLU Mumbai).

Question-04 What is CLTIBC and what's the task of CLTIBC?

Answer: Centre for Lex Tax & IBC at MNLU Mumbai is a specialised academic and research centre established with the aim to promote interdisciplinary engagement, research and capacity building in the fields of taxation laws, fiscal policy, and Insolvency & Bankruptcy Law.

Question-05 What is the objective of the Course?

Answer: The objective of the course is to enable participants to think critically and understand the regulatory frameworks concerning IBC.

Question-06 What is the total fee for the Certificate Course?

Answer: For UG & PG Participants : INR 4,000

For Ph.D Scholars & Professionals : INR 6,000.

Question-08: Who can apply for this Certificate Course?

Answer: Professionals such as Lawyers, Academicians from the field of Law, Commerce & Management, Bankers, Chartered Accountants, Company Secretaries, Insolvency Professionals, Ph.D. Scholars, UG & PG Students.

Question-09: What is the last date of applying for this Course?

Answer: The application window will be open till 30th May, 2026 (11:59 P.M.).

Mode of Course

Question-10 Is the Course fully Online, Hybrid or Classroom-based?

Answer: The Course is wholly online, including the sessions, assessment and grading will be done through online mode.

Question-11 Can I access recorded lectures?

Answer: There is no provision for recorded lectures.

Question-12 Do I need any specific software or equipment to participate?

Answer: No software is needed. The classes will be held using Google Classroom and Google Meet/ MS Teams.

Question-13 How long is the duration of the Course?

Answer: The Certificate Course requires a minimum of 40 hours of instruction.

Question-14 How long is the duration of the Session?

Answer: One session will be 2 hours/ 2 lectures. So, cumulatively there would be 20 Sessions i.e. 40 Hours/40 Lectures.

Question-15 What are the timings of classes/sessions?

Answer: The Classes will be scheduled over Friday, Saturday and Sunday, usually from 05:00 P.M. to 07:00 P.M.

- a) MCQ Test for 50 Marks and
- b) Subjective examinations for 50 Marks, cumulatively amounting to 100 Marks.
