Advertisement Call for Interview - Visiting Faculty (Hourly Basis)

The university is seeking dynamic and driven individuals to join as Visiting Faculty, for a duration of one semester from **August 1st, 2025**. The selected candidates will be responsible for teaching in the B.A., LL.B. (Hons) or LL.M. Programme.

Essential Qualification:

- **Master's degree in law/ Political science / Economics:** A Master's Degree (in relevant subject) with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale, wherever the grading system is followed). A relaxation of 5% may be provided at the graduate and master's level for the Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribe, and Differently-abled categories for the purpose of eligibility and for assessing good academic record during direct recruitment to teaching positions.
- Proficiency in written and spoken English.
- Demonstrable either research or teaching or professional experience in the course domain applied for.

Desirable:

- **UGC-NET/ SET:** Clearing the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC or the CSIR, or a similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SETNET is preferred.
- **PhD degree in law / Political science / Economics:** Candidate with a Ph.D. degree or those enrolled as Ph.D. candidates would be preferred.
- **Experience:** Teaching experience or handling academic (teaching and evaluation) responsibilities. Practical experience in handling legal matters in the relevant domain.

Responsibilities:

- Delivering lectures and conducting classroom exercises for core courses/electives in offline/ physical mode.
- Conducting tutorials and providing student consultations.
- Holding regular office hours to engage with students.
- Administering viva examinations and evaluating paper submissions.
- Assessing examination papers/ tests.
- Participating in institutional service activities.
- Mandatory presence on campus during all working days.

Remuneration:

- Remuneration will be determined based on academic qualifications and relevant experience.
